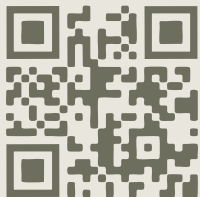
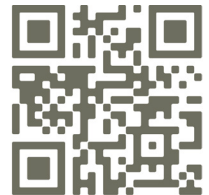
SPRING CLASSES

1 Corinthians 9:1-29

MAIN IDEA: *A life that is centered on the Gospel enables us to truly love others even at the expense of our own rights.*

THE GOSPEL FREES US (V. 1-14)

“AM I NOT FREE?”

THE GOSPEL COMPELS US (V. 15-23)

“FOR THOUGH I AM FREE FROM ALL, I HAVE MADE MYSELF A SERVANT TO ALL”

THE GOSPEL MOTIVATES US (V. 24-29)

“SO RUN THAT YOU MAY OBTAIN IT.”

DISCUSSION & REFLECTION QUESTIONS

- What stood out most to you from this sermon? Why?
- What are some rights that you possess that you hold onto strongly? Are there situations you can think of where you might be asked to give these rights up?
- To what lengths are you prepared to go to further the cause of the gospel? How does Paul's example challenge or encourage you?
