*TONIGHT | FEBRUARY 9TH AT 4:15PM | IN THE BOX*

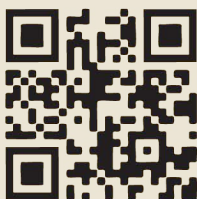

## **MEN, WOMEN, & THE TRINITY**

*1 Corinthians 11:2-16*

**MAIN IDEA:** *The relationship between husbands and wives is modeled after the Trinity and should be clearly displayed to the world.*

### **APPROACH TO TRICKY TEXTS:**

**JUST LIKE THE TRINITY, MEN AND WOMEN ARE EQUAL IN DEEP AND SIGNIFICANT WAYS.**

**JUST LIKE THE TRINITY, HUSBANDS AND WIVES PLAY DIFFERENT BUT EQUALLY IMPORTANT ROLES IN THEIR RELATIONSHIP.**

**JUST LIKE THE TRINITY, WE ARE CALLED TO JOYFULLY DISPLAY WHO WE TRULY ARE.**

### **DISCUSSION & REFLECTION QUESTIONS**

- What stood out most to you from this sermon? Why?
- Interpretation is the timeless truth and application is how it plays out today. Why is it important to not confuse the two?
- How does the Trinity deepen your understanding of the equality of men and women?
- How does the Trinity deepen your understanding of the differences between husbands and wives?
