THE ESSENTIAL GIFT

1 Corinthians 13:1-7

MAIN IDEA: Without Christ's love, even the greatest gifts are worthless.

Gifts Nullified (v. 1-3)

Love Personified (v. 4-7)

DISCUSSION & REFLECTION QUESTIONS

- What stood out most to you from this sermon? Why?
- Are you using your gifts in a way that reflects the heart of Christ's love? Are there times when you focus more on the outcome than the heart behind it?
- How can you guard against using your gifts in a way that looks good outwardly but is empty of true love? Where do you see the temptation to serve for recognition or out of obligation, rather than from a heart changed by Christ's love?
- How often do you find yourself trying to serve or love others out of your own strength rather than relying on Christ's love? How would your life be different if you more regularly rested in the love that Christ shows through the cross?
