1 CORINTHIANS - IN ALL THINGS

WHEN LOVE SPEAKS 1 Corinthians 14:1-25

MAIN IDEA: Love leads us to speak clearly, so the church is built up and the world sees Christ.

Love Truly (vs. 1-5) We pursue spiritual gifts not for self-expression, but to build up others.

Speak Clearly (vs. 6-19) If it can't be understood, it can't build up.

Think Maturely (vs. 20-25)

Rightly used gifts strengthen the church and reveal Christ to the world.
