PRAYER Mark 1:35-39

Jesus's example of prioritizing prayer (Mark 1:35; 6:46; 14:32–39, Luke 5:15-16, 6:12, 9:28)

Some of the Purposes of Prayer:

- To know Him (Philippians 3:7-11)
- To align our hearts with His (Mark 14:32-36)
- To make our requests to Him (Luke 18:1-8, Matthew 6:7-15, 7:7-11, Philippians 4:4-7)

- Adoration
- Confession
- <u>I</u>hanksgiving
- Supplication (asking)
