GRACE TO THE END

1 Corinthians 16:1-24

MAIN IDEA: *We are to step into the grace of gospel-shaped community by living generously, loving faithfully, and anticipating Christ's return.*

GIVE INTENTIONALLY (vs. 1-4)

LOVE RESILIENTLY (vs. 5-18)

ABIDE EXPECTANTLY (vs. 19-24)
