HIDDEN PROVIDENCE—A STUDY THROUGH ESTHER FOR SUCH A TIME AS THIS

Esther 4

MAIN IDEA: God's providence positions us, and his grace empowers us, to act with courage for his purposes.

Lament the Brokenness (v. 1-4)

Embrace your Position (v. 5-14)

Respond with Gospel Courage (v. 15-17)

DISCUSSION & REFLECTION QUESTIONS

- What stood out most to you from this sermon? What does God want you to do in response?
- Where do you see brokenness in the world or in your own life that you're tempted to ignore or numb rather than lament? How can gospel lament fuel action rather than paralyze you?
- Where has God uniquely placed you right now, in your family, work, neighborhood, or church? How might your current position be a calling, not just a coincidence?
- How does remembering the gospel empower you to act courageously? What would gospel courage look like in your life this week?
