Romans 5:1-11

Main Idea: *Through Christ, God has declared us definitively righteous, giving us peace with Him and hope in Him.*

What is Justification?

"We have been justified"

Why do we need it?

"We have peace with God and access into this grace"

How do we get it?

"Through our Lord Jesus Christ... by faith"
