KINGDOM STORIES: PARABLES IN LUKE
THE PRODIGAL SONS
Luke 15:11-32

Main Idea: *Whether in rebellion or religion, God's heart goes out toward the lost.*

Lost in Rebellion - The Younger Brother (vs. 11-20a)
"Give me the share of property that is coming to me."

Lost in Religion - The Older Brother (vs. 25-30)
"I have served you, and I never disobeyed your command."

The Father's Compassion for Both (vs. 20b-24, 31-32)
"It was fitting to celebrate and be glad, for this your brother was dead and is alive."

DISCUSSION & REFLECTION QUESTIONS

- What stood out most to you from this sermon? Why?
- Is your relationship with God more like the younger brother or the older brother? How do you experience God pursuing you in your rebellion or pride?
- How does the father's welcome of each of his sons help you to understand the gospel in new ways? Do you have a tendency to doubt the compassion of God?
- How can you cultivate a posture of humility that welcomes others' repentance and rejoices in God's grace?
- What does God want you to do in response to the message of this parable?
