## SET YOUR MIND ON THINGS ABOVE

Colossians 3:1-4

**Main Idea:** Setting our mind on things above is not passive — it's a daily, intentional partnership with God to guard, renew, and direct our thoughts toward Jesus.

### New Identity and New Way to Live

- With Christ being my very life, I have all of His resources to set my mind, thoughts, attention, and affections on things above

### Battle in the Mind

- Every moment of every day, whether we realize it or not, our thoughts are being shaped and formed by forces both seen and unseen

### Transformation is the Goal

- God transforms, but we participate and partner with Him

### Prayer is the Foundation

- Adopt a rhythm of prayer, worship, and gratitude throughout your day

### Consideration

- Paul is giving followers of Jesus an amazing challenge..set your mind on things above. Why? Because of these amazing truths he is writing about...you died with Christ, you have been raised with Christ, your life is hidden with Christ, and Christ is your very life! We have a new identity, a new way to live so of course we want to “set our mind on things above” because that is where true life really is!

### Discussion & Reflection Questions

- What stood out most to you from this sermon? Why?
- Have you considered that your mind is a battlefield where certain thoughts need to be confronted and surrendered to Christ?
- How can your new identity and way of life in Christ motivate you to set your mind on things above?
- What are you giving your thoughts and attention to that is forming your mind in an unhealthy way?
- What are ways to make these Biblical principles part of your daily rhythm and practice?
- What does “praying without ceasing” look like in your daily life?
