TITUS: FORMED BY THE GOSPEL **A PASSION FOR HOLINESS**

Titus 2:11-14

Main Idea: Embracing the fullness of our salvation motivates us to pursue holiness in every area of life!

Glorying in the fullness of our salvation...

- Grace has **SAVED** us (*Justification*) vs. 11
- Grace is **SHAPING** us (*Sanctification*) vs. 12
- Grace will **SUSTAIN** us (*Glorification*) vs. 13

...forms a people who are passionate to be holy and put Him on display! vs. 14

Discussion & Reflection Questions

- What stood out most to you from this sermon? Why?
- Why does the Lord care not only about what we do, but why we do it? What are some of the motivations (good or bad) that can drive obedience?
- How does reflecting on what Christ has done, is doing, and will do fuel a desire for holiness?
- Verse 14 says Jesus is forming a people “zealous for good works.” What good works is the Lord stirring in you right now?
- What is one specific way you want to respond this week as you “wait for our blessed hope”? How can you involve community in that response?
