*Luke 19:28-44*

Main Idea: It is possible to celebrate Jesus and still miss the peace He came to bring.

**The Peoples' Response: Celebration** (vs. 36-38)

**The Pharisees' Response: Suppression** (vs. 39-40)

**Jesus' Response: Lament** (vs. 41-44)

Discussion & Reflection Questions

- What stood out most to you from this sermon? Why?
- What does this text reveal about God's heart for those who have missed Him or misunderstand Him?
- What are the ways you tend to make Jesus the king of your agenda, rather than submitting to Him?
- What are the ways that you try to manage or control Jesus in order that your life remains comfortable?
- Are there any areas of your life that you demand peace from Jesus that He has never promised? What would it look like to grow in your understanding of "the things that make for peace"?
- What would it look like for you this week to not just celebrate Jesus, but to rest in the peace that's found through the cross?
