ROAD TO THE RESURRECTION

LIFE AFTER THE TOMB

Luke 24:13-53

Main Idea: Those who know the risen Jesus must trust His gospel and proclaim it to the world.

The Risen Jesus:

Reveals the Scriptures (*vs. 13-32*)

Assures His Followers (*vs. 33-49*)

Sends His Witnesses (*vs. 50-53*)

Discussion & Reflection Questions

- What stood out most to you from this sermon? Why?
- Is it surprising to you to hear that the whole Bible is pointing to Jesus? How does this change how you might engage with the Word of God?
- If Jesus really rose from the dead, how does it shape your hopes, fears, or priorities?
- What does it say about our reading of the Bible if the disciples could know the scriptures so well and still miss its central message?
- Why do you think Jesus was so careful to prove that his resurrection was physical? How does this impact your life?
- Who in your life needs to hear the hope of the resurrection proclaimed? How do you intend, with the Spirit's help, to respond to this?
