FAMILY OF PROMISE
THE GRACIOUS AND GOOD HAND OF GOD
Genesis 48-50 The Death of Jacob and Joseph

Main Point: The Lord's grace and goodness are at work in far greater ways than we can often see, giving us greater faith and trust in Him today.

The death of Jacob: A life demonstrating the grace and faithfulness of God to His promises! (*Genesis 48:1-50:14*)

The death of Joseph: A life demonstrating God's sovereign providence accomplishes His good purposes! (*Genesis 50:15-26*)

Discussion & Reflection Questions

- What has stood out to you most about the lives of Jacob and Joseph? How have their lives demonstrated the gracious and good hand of God? How does that strengthen your faith in Him today?
- What did Joseph have to believe about God in order to look at all that his brothers had done to him and say, "You meant evil against me, but God meant it for good"?
- How might Joseph's perspective change the way you view difficult circumstances in your own life?
- As you look back on our study of Genesis 25-50, what is one truth you hope will make a practical difference in your life a year from now?
