Ephesians 1:3-14

Main Point: The Holy Spirit guarantees our salvation, ensuring He will bring us safely home to enjoy our inheritance in Him for all eternity.

The Holy Spirit SEALS us at the moment of salvation... (vs. 13) *Romans 8:9*

...and GUARANTEES He will bring us safely home! (vs. 14) *John 10:28*

What is our inheritance? (1 Cor. 2:9, 2 Cor. 4:17, 1 Pet. 1:3-9, Rev. 21:1-4)

How do you know if you are sealed by the Holy Spirit? (Rom. 8:16, 1 John 5:13)

How does being secured in Christ fuel your passion for mission? (Rom. 10:14)
